### Background


- A site visit was conducted with the KZN EDTEA on 23 January 2017
- An IQ was submitted to the KZN EDTEA and the outcomes were:
  - The road rehabilitation can proceed without an EA
  - The culvert replacement proposed would be subject to a BA process

### Purpose


- Refresh the KZN EDTEA on the proposed project
- Seek guidance on the environmental assessment (BA) process intended by the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP – Royal HaskoningDHV)
- Seek clarity on aspects of uncertainty




# **Project Scope**









## **Alternatives Considered**

- Restricted and limited due to:
  - Rehabilitation of existing culverts
  - Location is fixed



## **Activities Triggered**

### Listing Notice 1

# **Basic Assessment Process and Timeframes**

# INCEPTION PHASE:

- Identify listed activities
- CA Preapplication meetings
- Site evaluations and Specialist Assessments
- Commence with PPP (BIDs, Site Notices, Adverts)

#### **BA PHASE**:

- Application for EA
- Draft BAR and EMPr PPP continues

# PUBLIC REVIEW PHASE:

Place BAR & EMPr for public review and comment

30 DAYS

#### **POST REVIEW:**

- Consolidate comments
- Address required changes
- Finalise the BAR and EMPr
- Submission of BAR and WULA to CAs

# AUTHORITY REVIEW & DECISION MAKING:

- Authorities assess and review to make decision
- Final distribution to I&APs

### OBJECTIVES

- Provide ample opportunity and channels for participation in the said project

## **Specialist Studies**

- Freshwater Habitat Assessment EcoPulse Consulting (includes vegetation)
- Heritage Assessment not planned as located within road reserve and replacement of existing culvert
- As EAP is from the same organisation as the Engineering team, a Peer-review will be done (Dr Richard Kinvig)



## **Clarification and Confirmation**

- Confirmation of approach presented
- Confirmation of specialist studies and no Heritage Assessment as proposed
- Confirmation of PPP as presented
  - Site Notices and BIDs can be circulated without EDTEA reference no.
- Landowner notification is this considered a linear project and therefore exempt as per Regulation 39 (2)?
