

1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Royal HaskoningDHV (RHDHV) was appointed by the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Transport (KZN DoT) to act as an independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) for the environmental authorisation application for the proposed rehabilitation of an existing culvert along the P230 from km 37,0 to km 47,0 near Empangeni, KwaZulu-Natal.

1.2 The Public Participation Process

Public participation is a process that is designed to enable all Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) to voice their opinion and/ or concerns which enables the practitioner to evaluate all aspects of the proposed development, with the objective of improving the project by maximising its benefits while minimising its adverse effects. I&APs include all interested stakeholders, technical specialists, and the various relevant organs of state who work together to produce better decisions.

The public participation process must adhere to the requirements of Regulations (GNR 543) under the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) (No 107 of 1998)(as amended).

The public participation process for the P230 culvert replacement Basic Assessment (BA) process has been undertaken according to the stages outlined below.



Figure 1-1: Stages of the Public Participation Process

Royal HaskoningDHV are conducting the Public Participation Process (PPP) for the P230 culvert replacement BA.

1.3 Purpose of the Report

The principal purpose of this Public Participation Summary Report is to:

- Summarise the public participation processes undertaken for the BA Process;
- Highlight what has been done to date;
- Synthesise the issues and concerns identified by I&APs and various stakeholders during the public participation process; and
- Synthesise comments on the proposed development.



1.4 Terms of Reference for Public Participation

One of the main aims of the public participation process is to serve as a structure for communication and consultation with I&APs. An outline of the communication efforts that was launched as part of this process are listed below. It should, however, be noted that this plan was adapted throughout the process to ensure successful communication and consultation by the public participation consultants to all I&APs.

The project team recognises successful communication as a relevant, timely, and continuous tool that enables the targeted project team, individual and groups of I&APs.

The terms of reference for the implementation of a successful and robust public participation programme, were as follows:

- Identification of I&APs in the vicinity of the study area:
- Provision to all I&APs of an opportunity to comment or raise concerns regarding the project;
- Maintenance of procedures for communication with I&APs and receiving, documenting and responding to relevant communication from I&APs;
- Identification and elimination of any sources of misunderstandings between the Applicant, Consultants and the I&APs;
- Always aim to improve the communication between the Consultants, the Applicant and I&APs;
- Present the project in an objective way by supplying all appropriate, relevant and accurate information and facts in an unbiased manner to ensure a better understanding of the proposed project; and
- Ensure that the public participation process is an independent and transparent process.

1.5 Public Participation Summary

The Public Participation Process commenced in June 2017 where site notices were erected at strategic locations along the alignment and in the study area. During this time comment forms and Background Information Document (BID) flyers were distributed to the Traditional Authority and Councillor as well as commenting authorities by hand and electronically. I&APs were introduced to the project and encouraged to register on the database.

An advertisement was placed in the Isolezwe newspaper on the 13th July 2017 followed by a comment period which was open for the I&APs to raise their issues and concerns regarding the proposed activity.

A draft Consultation Basic Assessment Report (cBAR) was compiled and the draft cBAR has been distributed to the relevant authorities and to the public for review, for a 30 day comment period in which I&AP's are afforded the opportunity to raise any further issues and concerns, until the finalisation of the document for submission to the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (KZN EDTEA).

2 IDENTIFICATION OF I&APs

Prior to commencement of the PP Process a detailed understanding of the project description was attained from the Applicant. Upon receiving the description a site visit was undertaken, this process was used to identify the following:

- Identify key areas of concern.
- Identify sites for the placing of the site notices.
- Attain a visual understanding of the project.
- Identify areas most impacted by the proposed development.



The first step in the PP Process entailed the identification of key I&APs and Stakeholders, including:

- Local and provincial government;
- Affected and neighbouring landowners;
- Environmental Non-Governmental Organisations; and
- Community Based Organisations.

An I&AP Database was compiled which has been maintained and updated throughout the duration of the BA process.

3 SITE NOTIFICATION

The NEMA EIA Regulations (2014 as amended in 2017) require that a site notice be fixed at a place conspicuous to the public at the boundary or on the fence of the site where the activity to which the application relates is to be undertaken and on any alternative sites. The purpose of this is to notify the public of the project and to invite the public to register as stakeholders and inform them of the PP Process. Royal HaskoningDHV erected site notices at various noticeable locations around the perimeter of the site and at strategic locations on or near the site (along the P230 and at the Empangeni Library). Site Notices were erected in isiZulu as the predominant language of the area.



What does this document tell you?

This document aims to provide you, as an Interested and Affected Party (I&AP), with background information regarding the initiative by the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Transport (KZN DoT), Empangeni Road Rehabilitation Programme, which aims at rehabilitating the existing P230 from kilometre (km) 37.0 (intersection with P393) to km 47.0 (Empangeni), KwaZulu-Natal.

This document provides information regarding the Basic Assessment (BA) and Water Use Authorisation (WUA) being undertaken, and also advises you on how you can become involved in the project - by reviewing information, and making inputs thereon, including raising any possible issues. This sharing of information forms the basis of the public participation process and offers you the opportunity to become actively involved in the project from the outset. Public participation allows for local knowledge to be integrated into the BA as generated.

Description of the proposed project

The project is located in the eastern part of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal. The work to be carried-out commences at the intersection of the P393 and P230, km 37,0 to km 47,0, uMhlathuze Local Municipality at Empangeni.

The P230 is a single carriageway road with an existing surface width of approximately 9,0m. This project aims at



rehabilitating approximately 10,0km of the P230 road while increasing the width of the road to 10,0m which would consist of two 3,5m lanes; two 1,5m surfaced shoulders and the construction of 1,0m wide gravel shoulders on both sides of the road and the replacement of one culvert at a water crossing. The proposed rehabilitation work is to be carried-out using half-width construction with stop/go conditions during the day and traffic signals at night.

Access to the site of the works can be obtained from either the Melmoth P47/4 (R34) / Eshowe P47/4 (R66) direction at km 37,0 or from the Empangeni P230 (R34) direction at km 47,0.

The proposed rehabilitation comprises the bulk earthworks, layerworks, surfacing, drainage work, ancillary works and replacement of one culvert required for the rehabilitation. As the rehabilitation of the road (i.e. bulk earthworks, layerworks, surfacing and ancillary works) did not trigger any listed activities, these activities could proceed whilst the Basic Assessment (BA) study for the culvert replacement is being undertaken.




Figure 1: Location contextualisation of study area

What are the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project?

Potential environmental impacts associated with the project have been identified. Therefore, as part of the BA, these potential impacts will be assessed through the following specialist study:

The EIA Regulations (2014 as amended in 2017) requires the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to be independent, objective and have expertise in conducting EIAs. Such expertise should include knowledge of all relevant legislation and of any guidelines that have relevance to the proposed activity. To ensure a lack of bias and to ensure transparency an external peer review will be undertaken prior to the public review during the formal BA process. This peer review will be conducted by Kinvig & Associates Environmental Consultants.

Input from the public through the public participation process provides valuable input in the identification of issues requiring investigation within this BA process. The study will highlight areas that should be avoided in order to minimise potential impacts, and evaluate the project alternatives. The BA will aim to achieve the following:

- Provide an overall assessment of the social and biophysical environments of the affected area by the proposed construction of the project;
- Undertake a detailed assessment of the culvert replacement in terms of environmental criteria including the rating of significant impacts;
- Identify and recommend appropriate mitigation measures for potentially significant environmental impacts; and
- Undertake a fully inclusive public participation process to ensure that I&AP issues and concerns are recorded and commented on.



Why are environmental studies needed?

In terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations Government Notice Regulation (GNR) 983 - 985 (amended by GNR 324 to 327 of 2017), published in terms of Section 24(5), and read with Section 44, of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) (Act No. 107 of 1998), the KZN DoT requires an Environmental Authorisation (EA) from the KZN Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (EDTEA) for undertaking the proposed project as it includes activities listed under Listing Notices 1 - 3 of the EIA Regulations (2014 as amended in 2017).

The following activities of GNR 983 are being applied for:

Activity 19 – The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 10 m³ into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 10 m3 from a watercourse.

Activities under these listings may have an effect on the environment, hence a Basic Assessment (BA) study as prescribed in Regulations 16 to 20 and Appendix 1 for a BA study and Regulations 16 - 18, 21-24 and Appendix 2 and 3 of the EIA Regulations (2014 as amended in 2017), will be undertaken. A BA is an effective planning and decision-making tool, which allows for the identification of potential environmental consequences of a proposed project, and its management through the planning process.

Additionally, as the project involves the crossing of watercourses, a Water Use Authorisation (WUA) will be submitted to the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) as per Sections 21 (c) and (i) of the National Water Act (Act No. 36 of

The following water uses of Section 21 of the NWA are being applied for:

- (c) Impeding or diverting the flow of water in a watercourse; and
- (i) Altering the bed, banks, course or characteristics of a watercourse.

The KZN DoT has appointed Royal HaskoningDHV to provide independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) services for the proposed project. As part of these environmental studies, all I&APs will be actively involved through a public participation process (PPP).

Public Participation Process (PPP)

It is important that relevant I&APs are identified and involved in the PPP from the outset of the project.

To ensure effective public participation, the process includes the following steps during the BA and WUA Process:

- STEP 1: Create awareness of the BA and WUA process (by way of advertisement in local newspaper, circulation of BID [this document] and erection of site notices);
- STEP 2: Register I&APs and key stakeholders on the database (on-going);
- STEP 3: Consultation with, and transfer of information to, I&APs through consultation and stakeholder engagement;
- STEP 4: Invite I&AP comment and input on the draft consultation BA report (BAR) (30-day comment period); and
- STEP 5: Record all comments, issues and concerns raised by I&APs within an issues trail, which will form an integral part of the BAR and WUA.
